### 28 Professionals Earn the Certified Licensing Professional (CLP) Credential in April 2013

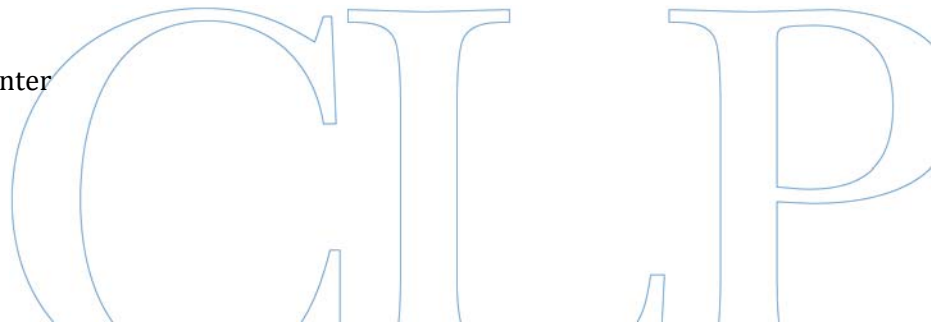
